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## Course Syllabus

**Course Title:** Medical Surgical II & Family Nursing

**Course Code:** NSG528 Clinical III

**Credit hours:** 3.0

**Clinical:** 135 total hours (45 contact hours per credit)

### **Description:**

This course is designed to develop application of the nursing process in the care of acutely and chronically ill patients, as well as family-centered care. The roles of medical-surgical and family health nurses are examined across roles, including the role of coordinator of care transitions. Clinical experiences integrate the concepts of caring, collaboration, communication, cultural sensitivity, community, and clinical judgment to facilitate the wellbeing of individuals and to prepare the student as a provider of care. In the clinical setting, students will care for patients with select medical, surgical, and/or family health problems in various settings, demonstrate knowledge of pathophysiology and psychosocial dynamics, apply the nursing process, utilize information technology, interact with other health care professionals, and practice clinical decision making and critical inquiry while caring for culturally diverse, ill adults.
